ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SAN SIMEON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ESTABLISHING SERVICE CHARGES AND CONNECTION FEES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE WITHIN THE DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the San Simeon Community Services District as follows:

<u>SECTION 1 - WATER RATES AND WATER CHARGES</u>: The rates, fees; and charges imposed and collected for monthly water service furnished by the District shall be as follows:

Restaurant	3.02
Residential	3.02
Motel	3.02
Irrigation	5.50

Any other structure, business, or private activities, or other use of water not covered herein, or any modification or change in the rates, fees and charges specified herein, may be set by the Board of Directors of the San Simeon Community Services District as authorized by law.

<u>SECTION 2 - SEWER RATES AND CHARGES</u>: The rates, fees, and charges imposed and collected for monthly sewer service furnished by the District shall be as follows:

Commercial Restaurant	2.48 6.64
Residential	2.48
Motel	4.00

Any other structure, business, or private activities, or other use of sewer not covered herein, may be set by the Board of Directors of the San Simeon Community Services District as authorized by law.

<u>SECTION 3 - METER CHARGE</u>: A fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per month for each meter installed is imposed to be collected in addition to the applicable monthly water and sewer charges.

<u>SECTION 4 - WATER AND SEWER CONNECTION FEES</u>: The fees imposed for connecting to the District water and sewer system are as follows:

<u>SECTION 5 - ENABLING LAW</u>: This Ordinance is passed and adopted pursuant to the provisions of Government Code section 61000 et seq. and particularly Sections 61621 and 61621.5 thereof.

<u>SECTION 6 - REPEAL</u>: All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 7 - EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE</u>: This Ordinance shall be in force immediately after its passage and applied to meters regularly read in the month of April, 1993.

SECTION 8 This Ordinance shall be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District, if there is one, and if not, then this Ordinance shall be posted for one week in three (3) public places in the District.
