SANDBAGS: FILLING & LOADING TIPS

Sand is available at the District office free of charge. You will need to bring your own sand bags. Here are some general tips to help prevent injuries when filling and loading sandbags:

- Use gloves to protect hands from chemically-treated sandbags and contaminants in sand and floodwater.
- Avoid touching your eyes and mouth.
- Wear work boots (waterproofed if working in floodwater.)
- Use waterproof gear if working in floodwater or rain.
- Remember, sandbags may be small, but they are heavy. Use care when lifting.
- Do not overfill sandbags - fill bag 1/2 to 2/3 full.
- Keep load in front of and close to your body.
- Keep the lift between knee and waist height.
- Do not reach out, bend over, or twist when lifting.
- Lift with your legs, not your back.
