WEED ABATEMENT: HYDRANTS, METER BOXES

All property owners should start the weed abatement process.

As a reminder, the District will begin performing weed abatement along all District easements, hydrants and meter areas. Please do not place items on top of the meter boxes/lids or allow over growth of plants to cover the meter boxes. These items/plants must be removed by District Staff to read the meter. Also, if you have plants or shrubs that approach or cover fire hydrants, these plants will be cut back. There must be a 3 foot clearance around fire hydrants at all times.

FLAG ETIQUETTE

The Flag Code, which formalizes and unifies the traditional ways in which we give respect to the flag, also contains specific instructions on how the flag is not to be used. They are:

- The flag should never be dipped to any person or thing. It is flown upside down only as a distress signal.
- The flag should not be used as a drapery, or for covering a speaker's desk, draping a platform, or for any decoration in general. Bunting of blue, white and red stripes is available for these purposes. The blue stripe of the bunting should be on the top.
- The flag should never be used for any advertising purpose.
- The flag should not be used as part of a costume or athletic uniform, except that a flag patch may be used on the uniform

and members of patriotic organizations.

- The flag should never have placed on it, or attached to it, any mark, insignia, letter, word, number, figure, or drawing of any kind.
- The flag should never be used as a receptacle for receiving, holding, carrying, or delivering anything.
- When the flag is lowered, no part of it should touch the ground or any other object; it should be received by waiting hands and arms. To store the flag it should be folded neatly and ceremoniously.
- The flag should be cleaned and mended when necessary.
- When a flag is so worn it is no longer fit to serve as a symbol of our country, it should be destroyed by burning in a dignified manner.
