Summary:

Specialized Utility Services Program (SUSP) executed an agreement with San Simeon Community Services District (SSCSD) [**Water System ID CA4000568**] on November 21, 2019, and was tasked to conduct a Median Household Income (MHI) survey within the SSCSD service area. Multi-agency Guidelines for MHI Surveys California Department of Public Health, State Water Resource Control Board (SWRCB), and United States Department of Agriculture - Rural Development June 2014 were utilized to conduct the survey.

SUSP conducted the survey as a nonpartisan third-party non-profit organization. In the case of SSCSD, the American Census Survey (ACS) 2010 decadal census data includes populations outside of the SSCSD boundaries, which could skew SSCSD MHI level higher affecting funding eligibility for State and Federal grants and loans. This locally focused income survey depicts a precise MHI level of the residential community served by SSCSD.

SSCSD is located along the coastal plain, it is on the boarder of the Pacific Ocean to the west and to the east, the Santa Lucia mountain range. San Simeon's foundations were created in the 1960's and continued into the 1970's. The community is governed by a five-member board of directors that meet once monthly.

SSCSD provides water to approximately 462 residents via 200 Residential homes and 3 Vacant homes. The SSCSD universe of 200 households falls into the 181-238 household range that requires a sample size of **67 percent** to meet the most recent Multiagency Guidelines for Median Household Income (MHI) Surveys (2014). SSCSD needed 134 valid survey responses to meet the response rate. SUSP obtained **95 valid survey responses and upon approval from SWRCB - Division of Financial Assistance**

(DFA) defaulted 39 responses to the highest income level received (\$701,616) to meet the sample size percentage. It was determined that even if the remaining 39 households (needed to obtain the **72 percent response rate**) had responded with an income of **\$701,616** (the highest reported), The system would still have an MHI of no higher than **\$49,000**.

SUSP determined that SSCSD's Median Household Income is \$49,000.00.

Methodology:

A mailing list was provided via email to SUSP by Cortney Murgua of San SSCSD on February 11th, 2020. This initial list provided by SSCSD contained mailing addresses for 272 customers. The original mailing list was reviewed to ensure that there were no duplicates, errors, commercial business, and lot vacancies.

On March 20th, 2020, SSCSD sent an introductory letter to their customers stating that the company is seeking funding for system improvements (Exhibit A). The letter explained that a determination of the MHI within the service boundary is necessary to determine the type of funding eligibility. The letter stressed the importance of completing and returning the survey and that SUSP was designated to conduct as a third-party. The community of SSCSD is known to have primarily Spanish speaking residents and SUSP accommodated English and Spanish translations for all community outreach (See exhibits).

On March 23rd, 2020, SUSP mailed the first MHI survey to 272 households from the mailing list provided by the system.

On April 27th, 2020, SUSP mailed the Second MHI survey to 185 households from the remaining households yet to respond.

On June 29th, 2020, SUSP mailed the Third MHI survey to 134 households from the remaining households yet to respond.

On September 14th, 2020, SUSP mailed the Fourth and Final MHI survey to 112 households from the remaining households yet to respond.

Returned surveys resulted in the tabulation of 78 completed English responses, 17 Spanish completed surveys, 65 Vacation homes, 3 Vacant homes, and 4 Commercial properties. SSCSD's household universe size was adjusted from 272 to 200. The tabulations for each mailing attempt can be found in the "Survey Results" section of this report.

By December 1, 2020, SUSP had received 95 valid survey responses. Due to constraints and limitations of COVID-19 safety protocols, door-to-door survey responses were not collected for this survey. With the permission of the SSCSD, SUSP contacted the SWRCB-DFA for the use of default responses. DFA approved the use of default responses to fulfill the minimum response threshold. All SUSP mailings included a pre-paid self-addressed return envelope, survey, and an informational letter about the purpose and instructions of the survey.

After collecting and analyzing the data received, SUSP made the following corrections:

- Household Universe changed from 272 to 200 when 4 address were confirmed as a Commercial Business, 3 as Vacant homes, and 65 Vacation homes.
- 5 of the addresses were returned to SUSP as undeliverable. (Exhibit D)

The number of households changed to the range between **181 - 238** requiring a sample size of 67 percent, from the original range between 239 - 308 requiring a 57% response rate. The 95 valid responses failed to meet the required response rate. A request was submitted to DFA to default the remaining responses to the highest value recorded. DFA approved the use of default responses (Exhibit A).

SUSP determined that San Simeon CSD's Median Household Income is \$49,000.

Good morning Thomas,

This email is to reply to your correspondence dated January 16, 2020, regarding your request to have an income survey conducted for the San Simeon Community Services District. The Median Household Income (MHI) from American Community Survey 5-year Estimates has been determined to be unreliable for the proposed service area due to lack of available data for the San Simeon Census-Designated Place.

Concurrence by the funding agency to proceed with an income survey is subject to conformance with the following methodology when conducting the survey:

1. Assurance will be provided that the MHI resulting from the survey defines household as a person or group of people who occupy a housing unit as their usual place of residence and that the household income is the total amount of income received by all household members 15 years old and over, for the latest tax year (i.e., 2013 data is collected for a survey conducted between April 15, 2014 and April 15, 2015; 2014 data is collected for a survey conducted between April 15, 2015 and April 15, 2016; etc.). Income includes any sources of gross income received regularly from employment, net business or farm income, veteran's payments, unemployment compensation, child support, Social Security or supplemental security income, public assistance, retirement, survivor or disability pensions, interest payments, or alimony. Income received by children under the age of 15 for work such as baby sitting, paper routes, or lawn mowing does not need to be included.
2. Every household within the MHI income survey boundary needs to have an equal opportunity to be included in the sample. There are two options to use in order to select households to be surveyed:
 - a. If the service area has less than or equal to 3,300 service connections, every household will be contacted. The minimum number of responses required is based on the number of households in the service area and is outlined in the table below.
 - b. If the service area is greater than 3,300 service connections the households to be surveyed can be selected using a random numbers table or a random numbers generator such as available on the following two websites; www.randomizer.org and www.random.org. Both give guidance on how to choose random numbers for surveys, and will generate a list of random numbers. The minimum number of responses required is based on the number of households in the service area and is outlined in the table under Item No. 5 below. It is advisable to obtain more than the minimum number of required samples in case unreachable households, unoccupied homes, and other nonresponsive situations are encountered. Nonresponsive households may be replaced with households on the reserve list in the order the replacements were selected. For example, if a list of 200 households is drawn in an effort to obtain 152 interviews, the first household designated as unreachable should be replaced by the 153rd household in the sample. If a door to door survey is conducted, two or more passes through the area at different times should be attempted. With a telephone survey three calls should be attempted before replacing a household with another one from the reserve list.
3. The system shall send an introductory letter using the template provided in this guide. Then, the third party surveyor will send a letter with the survey form to each home within the permitted service area, using the templates provided in this guide. Surveys may be returned by mail. If the occupant does not

return a completed form, it may be necessary to go door to door. The funding agency must approve the letter explaining the need for the income survey and the survey methodology before the survey is started. Once the survey is completed it must be used in all funding projects regardless of whether it results in a higher or lower MHI than previously.

4. Documented evidence will be provided that the households in the proposed service area (universe) have been contacted by phone, letter, or visit. Each household needs to complete the survey and return it even if it is a rental property.
5. Documentation will be provided that the survey results are statistically accurate reflecting at least a minimum response rate as outlined in the table below. The following response rates are minimum guidelines and may be held to a higher percentage of response if required by other co-funding sources to avoid the duplication of work in completing the income surveys. The universe is defined as all households occupied for six months out of the year.

6. A reliable impartial party who is not associated with the project will conduct the survey and will certify the results obtained as well as how the random samples were selected. The party selected to conduct the survey must be approved by the funding agency prior to beginning the income survey.
7. The actual income survey results will be submitted to the funding agency for review and concurrence. The median income is defined as that income in the middle of the data collected from the universe after all incomes are ranked in order from lowest to highest incomes. For example, if there nine houses surveyed, and the five ranks of income are \$15k, \$16k, **\$17k**, \$18k, \$19k, then \$17k is the median income because it is two from the top and two from the bottom rank. The median may require averaging if you have an even number of universe data available, and the two incomes in the middle are different.
8. The final report should include the following; a copy of any initial results letter, a summary of the income survey methodology, survey results, response rate calculations, service boundary map, residents list (including homes that responded, didn't respond, vacant lot/homes, and commercial properties), sample letters and forms, and median household income data table.
9. Evidence will be provided that there is a reliable method in place to identify each potential survey responder and further to cross reference each responder with corresponding survey returns.
10. The funding agency holds the right to audit the data five years from date published.

The key to the user list and the actual survey returns will be available to the funding agency for review.

Hello,

CRWA is seeking authorization to conduct a Median Household Income (MHI) survey for San Simeon CSD (CA4000568), per the attached Multi-Agency Guidelines. The district received the following information from the Regional Quality Control Board related to their current MHI status:

Currently we are using 2017 American Community Survey Data to qualify communities for small disadvantaged community funding. There is no data for San Simeon during this years data. The 2016 data is too high to qualify for grant funding and the 2015 data is missing. So the community will need an income survey to qualify for grant funding if that is what they are seeking. The community would qualify for low interest loans if they are not a small disadvantaged community. Here is the information that I pulled on the Median Household Income.

Hello Ibyang,

I was asked by Zoe to forward any miscellaneous MHI inquiries and emails to you, but please let me know if I should forward this to someone else at DFA.

That being said, SUSP (a subsidiary of CRWA) has been in the process of conducting a MHI Survey of the customers of San Simeon CSD (SSCSD).

272 households were initially surveyed requiring a response rate of 57%. After excluding vacation and vacant addresses discovered, the new household universe size is 200,

requiring a 67% response rate. Based on our current MHI Guidelines, the minimum responses needed to complete this survey is 134. SUSP is requesting an exemption to this minimum threshold requirement on this particular project for the following reasons:

- Per communication with SWRCB, SUSP has been directed to decrease the survey household universe whenever we receive a vacant, vacation, or commercial business survey response.
- Our survey of San Simeon found 3 vacant homes, 65 vacation homes, and 4 commercial businesses; leaving 200 households to survey (2 households have also refused to participate which is preventing CRWA from collecting data). The 95 responses CRWA has received accounts for a 47.5% response rate. The number of households in a range between 181-238 requires a sample size of 67% (134 responses) to meet our guidelines for MHIs. We are requesting approval to default the final 39 responses to the highest value reported in order to meet the 67% requirement.
- CRWA has determined that even if the remaining 39 households (needed to obtain the 67% **response rate**) had responded with an income of the highest income reported, the system would still have a MHI of no higher than **\$49,000**.
- Based on the information currently available, SSCSD's MHI is **\$49,000.00**. Please see attached our spreadsheet for the current results as well as a spreadsheet outlining the results containing the defaulted responses.

Since CRWA does not believe that any further survey work will bear out substantially different results, we request to conclude our survey gathering efforts and begin work on a Final Report for this project by defaulting the final necessary responses to the highest value reported. Please advise on next steps and let us know if you have any questions or concerns.


